

Singapore Border Restrictions

In line with COVID-19 alerts, there are new Border Control Measures for short-term visitors travelling into Singapore which will affect our patients coming into Singapore for treatment. Please be informed that short-term visitors will NOT be allowed to enter or transit through Singapore as of Monday 23rd March 11.59pm until further notice, unless they obtain a waiver or require urgent medical evacuation.

For Local Singapore-based Patients:

Icon Cancer Centre and Icon Haematology clinics in Singapore remain open.

For Overseas Patients:

Supporting you to access the medical care you need is incredibly important to Icon and our doctors. If you have been receiving care at Icon Cancer Centre and Icon Haematology, our team will continue to support you during this challenging period. Icon will provide the following remote support services to meet your healthcare needs:

- Telemedicine services are available for consultations with Icon doctors when you are in your home country
- Home delivery of medication, based on prescription only, to most ASEAN countries including Indonesia and Vietnam
- Access to a share care network via Icon's healthcare partners overseas, which can be arranged should you need treatment of medical care in your home country
- Application for medical waiver and medical evacuation to travel to Singapore for treatment and medical care on case to case basis (Subject to MOH Singapore's approval)
